God's sense of timing is not predictable. It is all about His timing. But in this time of waiting I was left wanting. Wanting to hear from God and wanting to know His agenda for my life. Missing God is a wake-up call. Without Him we

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are like a car without anyone in the driver seat. Yes, I know we have driverless cars but have you seen how many of them crash? I realized that I needed God in the driver seat to keep me on course. I needed to sit beside Him and go to wherever He was taking me. The silence can be deafening. I hate silence. But in the end, I have found something new was taking shape in my life.

If you can hold on, you will see that in the silence and in the waiting, God will give you something far greater than an "answer."

Would you be willing to obey? You'd be foolish not to!
